CODE OF PRACTICE FOR MEMBERS

Blitz TTC is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well-being of all its members. The Club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the Club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the Club with either the Welfare Officer or any serving Committee member.

As a member of Blitz TTC, you are expected to abide by the following Code of Practice:

1. All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions
2. All members must respect the rights, dignity, and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity
3. Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their Coach or team manager if they are going to be late
4. Members must wear suitable kit for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager. This should include, as a minimum, trainers/plimsoll (preferably white sole) and non-white shirts/shorts/skirts/tracksuits
5. Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly
6. Members are not allowed to smoke on Club premises or whilst representing the Club at competitions
7. Members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the premises or whilst representing the Club

CODE OF PRACTICE FOR PARENTS/CARERS
